

Parent Intake forms:

Must be filled in before the first session, unless there are circumstances with some urgency.

The fee per session will be agreed according to income. I may need a phone session with both parents, before the first session, to clarify some of the information on the intake forms. This will be charged at the same rate as the agreed session rate, and could be from half an hour to one and half hours.

First session:

If both parents are raising the child together I request that they both come to the initial session. It is highly recommended that both parents come to all sessions.

Additional support:

Phone consults are available to parents in between sessions. The fee rate will be the same as for face to face sessions, and will be paid at the next session.

Individual parent sessions:

At times it may be appropriate for one or both parents to have a few sessions together, or individually, without their child present. The purpose for these sessions will be to help the parents look at some of their own issues which might be in the way of their child's development. These sessions, like all the others, are conducted and centered from the perspective of the child's issues and needs for growth.

Other adults at sessions:

Occasionally, it is appropriate for a family member other than the parents and child to be present. This could be a father who doesn't live with the child, a grandparent, a sibling who doesn't usually come, a sibling of a parent. If you wish to bring an additional person, please discuss this with me first. Sometimes it is not appropriate. A phone session may be necessary with the additional person before they come to the session. They will be required to fill in the intake form.

Commitment:

I appreciate that families commit to the process until the parenting issues are resolved.

Parents must be committed to using nonviolent methods of discipline (no spanking, hitting, shaking or other physical discipline or punishment).
